In compliance with RoHS directives, Century Seals, Inc. does not intentionally add banned substances or Phthalates to plating solutions, and to the best of our knowledge, our chemical and plating bath suppliers provide products that are also free of the same hazardous components. It should be noted that trace amounts of chemicals and other substances may occur as impurities in any product; however, neither Century Seals, Inc. nor its suppliers test for substances not intentionally added.

Please note that tin-lead plating has long been accepted as a plating finish for connectors, and when specified by clients, Century Seals, Inc. will continue to supply this finish but will be unable to provide certification of compliance with RoHS.
